

## **Project #1**

### **“Awesome Movie”**

#### **Description**

For this first project, you are going to create a single “movie review” page – a discussion about any movie of your choice, with images, text, and links to provide some interesting content about this movie for your visitor. Whether this information is factual or fictional, a critical review or a facetious anecdote is entirely up to you. Note, however, that I want YOU to create the text content that goes on your page (do NOT copy someone else’s review or plot summary). Be creative and have fun with this.... The project is about web page design with text, images, and links, so the choice of movie and quality of content are not important – just how well you put it together as a page, both in style and intrigue.

#### **Requirements**

Your page needs to include the following elements:

- At least 3 images, formatted appropriately to your design
- At least 3 different text formats (paragraph, headline, list, styles, etc.)
- Intentional schemes for font; font-size; background, text, and link colors; and margins – no “defaults”
- At least 2 external links (maybe to more info about your chosen movie, or resources that you drew from?)
- An additional “internal” link back to the Movie Selection Menu that I will create to interconnect everyone’s pages ([www.pixelweavers.org/projects/movies.html](http://www.pixelweavers.org/projects/movies.html))
- Your page must be titled!!

#### **Scoring**

To remind you of what the syllabus says on scoring: “1/3 of the score will come from satisfactorily completing the requirements outlined [above], and 2/3 will be based on creativity, good use of skills learned, and overall interest and usability of the pages you create.” Remember, **spelling counts!** Use Dreamweaver’s spellchecker or have a friend proofread your page.

#### **Due Date**

The “Awesome Movie” web page is due at the beginning of class on Tuesday, 23 September (note that this is one class period later than the critique date listed on the syllabus). Your page needs to be uploaded to your PixelWeavers’ web account **before** class. Any page not uploaded at the beginning of class will be late and lose a letter grade, followed by an additional letter grade for each day that it is late after that!
